KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Create a fun, inclusive, and positive environment where all players feel welcome and supported
- Ensure the safety and well-being of all players
- Help support weekly practices and games, tailored to the age and skill level of your group
- Encourage teamwork, sportsmanship, and skill development
- Communicate with parents and PYSA staff as needed
- Set a great example as a positive role model both on and off the field
- Assist with field setup, including lining fields, pumping balls, goal maintenance, and ensuring storage units remain clean, tidy, and well-organized.

WHO CAN VOLUNTEER?

- Parents, guardians, and caregivers of PYSA players
- No previous coaching or teaching experience required, just a willingness to learn!
- Previous soccer experience (as a player, volunteer, referee, or coach) is an asset but not necessary
- A Vulnerable Sector Criminal Record Check is required



COMMITMENT

- 1-2 sessions per week (practice and/or game)
- Priority given to volunteers available two days a week, with majority of programs taking place on Wednesdays and Saturdays
- Seasons run in Fall (early September to late October) and Spring (early April to late June)

- Receive support, resources, and optional training from PYSA
